Family, heritage, and where we fit

- 1 Is there a saying an older person in your family uses often? What do you think they really mean by it?
- 2 What is something your family does that you have never seen another family do?
- 3 If you could ask one question of a relative you never met, what would it be?

EFFORT & FINISHING · THE SUMMER MALIK STARTED

Starting, showing up, finishing

- 1 What is something you started but never finished? What got in the way?
- 2 Is there a difference between not caring about something and pretending not to care?
- 3 What is one thing you could begin this week – even before you feel ready?

RESPONSIBILITY & INDEPENDENCE · THE NO-NAG PLAN

Ownership and being trusted

- 1 What is one thing you get reminded to do that you honestly wish you could just handle yourself?
- 2 What would change at home if the reminders stopped – for you, and for the adult doing the reminding?
- 3 What is one responsibility you would actually want more control over?

COURAGE & BEING SEEN · WHEN FEAR WORE EARRINGS

Visibility, courage, self-expression

- 1 Is there a part of yourself you show some people but not others? Why those people?
- 2 What is the difference between being confident and looking confident?
- 3 When is it hardest to be yourself – and when is it easiest?
